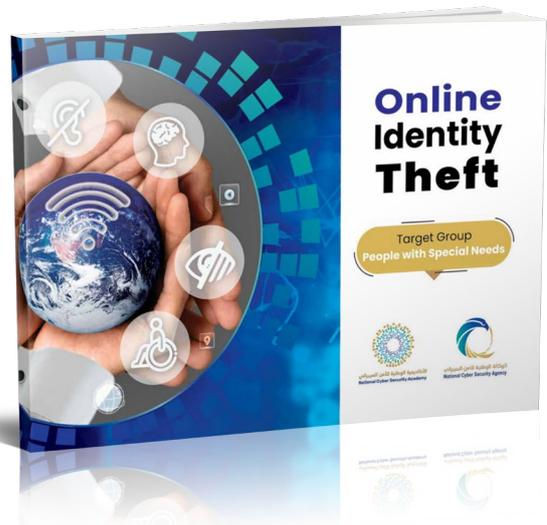

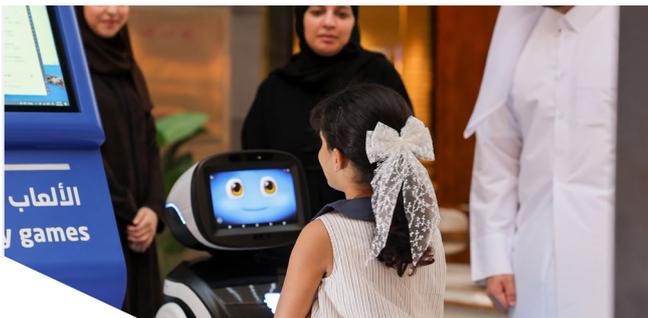

Broad reach and comprehensive coverage



The Cybersecurity Awareness Portal provides broad coverage across different segments of society. It aims to deliver awareness-raising content widely and comprehensively, reaching the following locations:



Interactive Robot An Intelligent Assistant for Better Digital Safety

At the centre of the stand, an AI-powered robot welcomes visitors, holding human-like conversations and providing instant responses to enquiries about cybersecurity. Beyond answering questions, it offers tailored guidance to correct unsafe digital practices and can interact in Qatari Arabic or English.

Ranging from simple questions to complex threats, the robot provides clear, accurate answers about passwords, phishing, ransomware protection, and more.



Virtual Reality (VR) An Immersive Cybersecurity Experience



At the Cybersecurity Awareness Portal, participants use virtual reality (VR) headsets to enter an immersive, interactive 3D environment that simulates a battle between digital protection tools and cyberattack threats.

Visitors watch an interactive video that explains key concepts including two-factor authentication (2FA), strong passwords, and data security in a visually engaging format suitable for all ages.

The VR video offers a distinctive experience for different segments of society, featuring characters that reflect society as a whole. The awareness-raising content is presented in an innovative format that enhances the user experience and supports the objectives of the National Initiative for Digital Safety.

Interactive Displays Interactive Educational Content



The stand features four interactive displays offering educational content, learning games, and interactive cybersecurity challenges. These displays also feature videos from the Cyber 365 program, games from the National Initiative for Digital Safety, and games from the school field visits project Cyber Eco. Additionally, they run cybersecurity competitions featuring interactive quiz questions, with participants receiving token gifts on completion.

Video Games: Entertainment and Learning

Recognising the importance of video games and their ability to integrate entertainment with learning, the National Cyber Security Agency is committed to offering a wide range of games through the Cybersecurity Awareness Portal. Vendôme Mall



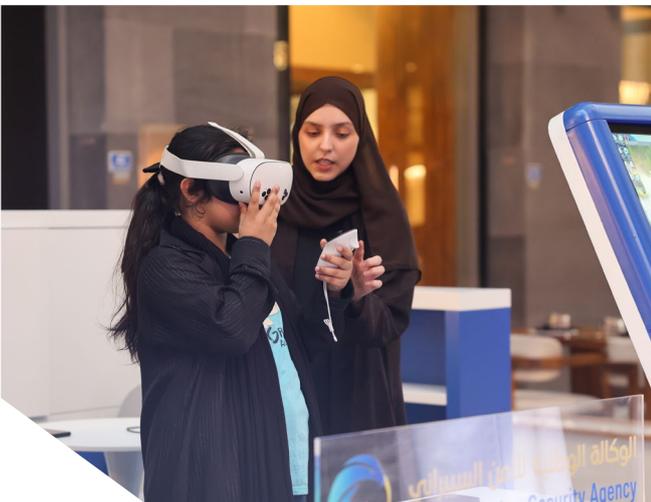
